
Our Policy Team takes what we know and works alongside other education and employment sector leaders to build the case for large-scale government intervention.

Set (and reach!) your goals

Pages with a set target raise 17% more. Don't forget that by signing up, you've committed to raise either £500 (individual entry) or £1,200 (team entry).

Spread the word

Make the most of your personal and professional connections - add a link to your email signature, put it on your Instagram story or post on LinkedIn.

Add your 'why'

Information about Impetus will automatically appear on your page once it's created, but how about making it more personal - share why this cause really matters to you.

Start as you mean to go on

People who donate to their own page to get it started raise 84% more. Even a small donation helps.

Our valued partner Inflexion take the trophy for highest fundraiser every year and it's time to give them some competition!

Inflexion ask their portfolio firms to join them in competing at the Triathlon, and will pay for their registration fees as an incentive.

If the portfolio firm doesn't attend, Inflexion will then ask them to support their fundraising with a donation.
