

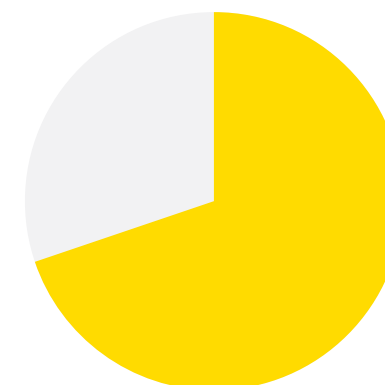


There are **7** million young people in the UK*

67% of Newcastle's NEET
population have had repeated
contact with social care
(compared to only 25% of all Newcastle's 17-19 year olds)

THIS AFFECTED THEIR CHANCES OF BEING NEET ...



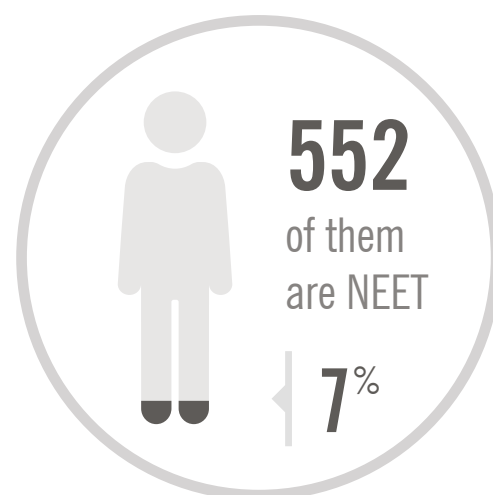
5^x more likely if they have been Looked After by the local
authority *(and spend 10x longer NEET – 15 months vs. 1.5 months)*



3^x more likely if they have had substantial contact with
Children's Social Care



2^x more likely if they are eligible for free school meals

WHAT'S NEEDED

Young people who face personal challenges warranting repeated contact with social care are more likely to become NEET.
These young people need to be targeted with early intervention and holistic support, both at home and in school.
